What is GDPR?

INTEGRITY

Processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security of the personal data, including protection against unauthorized or unlawful processing, and accidental loss, destruction or damage

STORAGE LIMITATION

Data should only be kept as long as it is needed. If no longer needed the data shoul

LAWFULNESS

Processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner in relation to the data subject

GDPR Personal Data Principles

ACCURACY

Accurate and kept upto-date, having regard to the purpose for which it's processed, and correct it if not

PURPOSE LIMITATION

Collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes and not further processed in a manner that is incompatible with those purposes

DATA MINIMIZATION

Adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purpose for which they are processed
