Ratified by all parties and entered into force in may 2018

- APECS refine and standardise (March/April 2021)
- Online tool on INTERACT website (May 2021)

## Experiences

No country as a single entry point for Scientists

- Svalbard comes close
- Additional resources needed to coordinate efforts

Some countries have initiated internal processes following our contact

In many cases, information and application documents are not available in English

Research stations often fill the role of advicing scientist on what permits are required



System needs regular attention, to prevent dead links and ensure updated information
